# Summer Reading is almost here!



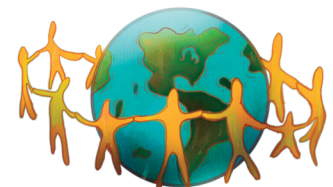
This year's Summer Reading program is called All Together Now, which focuses on helping the community and being kind to others.
