### **SUMMER READING** PROGRAM 2023

The Shelbyville - Bedford County Public Library was proud to present our 2023 Summer Reading Program "All Together Now" this year! The Library again partnered with The Fly hosted children from the Boys and Girls Club, the SACP, and the Summer Program at East Side Elementary. Despite some rain, we had good finale events the last week of the program. We also debuted our adult summer reading challenge this year to expand our program and had 46 adults register for the inaugural year!



SBCPL registered over 350 Summer Reading participants and had 2,419 children, teens, and adults in attendance to in-person events over the weeks of Summer Reading. The 90 programs included performers, nutrition classes, escape rooms, crafts, STEAM activities, and Bookmobile. The Library would like to thank all of the children, teens, parents, grandparents, and anyone else who attended these programs as well as all our performers, staff, and volunteers! This year's Summer Reading Program would not have been a success without your participation.
